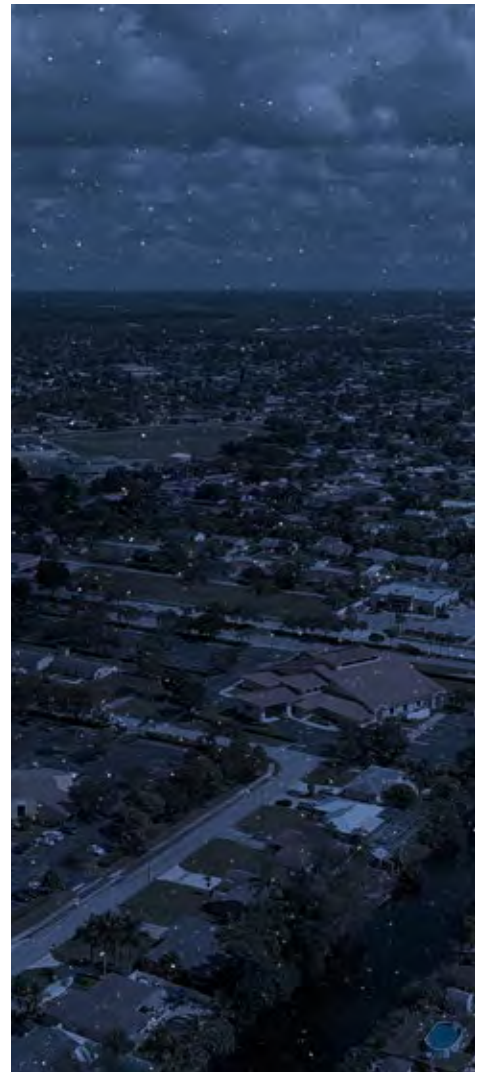

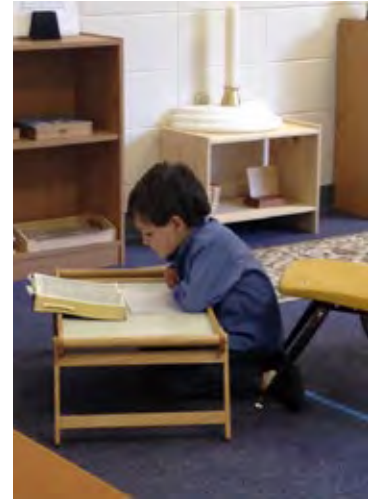
COMING IN 2023: THE ATRIUM!
