The Blessed Path

In the readings since Christmas, Jesus has been revealed as the new royal son of David and Son of God. He is sent to lead a new exodus that brings Israel out of captivity to the nations and brings all the nations to God. As Moses led Israel from Egypt through the sea to give them God's law on Mount Sinai, Jesus too has passed through the waters in baptism. Now, in today's Gospel, He goes to the mountain to proclaim a new law—the law of His Kingdom. The Beatitudes mark the

fulfillment of God's covenant promise to Abraham—that through his descendants all the nations of the world would receive God's blessings (see Genesis 12:3; 22:18).

Jesus is the son of Abraham (see Matthew 1:1). And through the wisdom He speaks today, He bestows the Father's blessings upon "the poor in spirit."

God has chosen to bless the weak and lowly, those foolish and despised in the eyes of the world, Paul says in today's Epistle. The poor in spirit are those who know that nothing they do can merit God's mercy and grace. These are the humble remnant in today's First Reading, taught to seek refuge in the name of the Lord. The Beatitudes reveal the divine path and purpose for our lives. All our striving should be for these virtues—to be poor in spirit; meek and clean of heart; merciful and makers of peace; seekers of the righteousness that comes from living by the law of Kingdom.



The path the Lord sets before us today is one of trials and persecution. But He promises comfort in our mourning and a great reward. The Kingdom we have inherited is no earthly territory but the promised land of heaven. It is Zion where the Lord reigns forever. And, as we sing in today's Psalm, its blessings are for those whose hope is in the Lord. *Reflection by Scott Hahn*

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD!

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2023 | MASS AT 7PM (BILINGUAL)

Luke's Gospel is the only one to mention the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. February 2 is exactly forty days after December 25, the nativity of Jesus. Jewish law (Ex 13:2, 12) dictated that Jesus, as the firstborn, be consecrated to God. This was done by the parents as they presented their Son in the Temple.

Jewish law further specified (Lv 12:2-8) that a mother was ritually impure after giving birth, and that she had to wait a set period of time (forty days for a boy) before she was to offer a sacrifice to the Lord for purification.

The convergence of these two Jewish regulations occasions Luke's account of both the Presentation of the Lord and the Purification of Mary. These days the liturgical emphasis is more on the Presentation of Jesus. Luke highlights the role of Simeon and Anna, two righteous Jews who recognized Jesus as the long-awaited Messiah and praised God for being able to see and experience such a marvel in their lifetimes.

Simeon's prayer concerning the special role of Jesus states that Jesus is "a light for revelation to the Gentiles." This phrase eventually originated the custom of blessing candles on this day which were to be used in the ceremonies, rituals, and processions throughout the church year. Thus February 2 is also known as Candlemas Day. This day is indeed a rich feast to be savored.

All are welcome to bring candles to be blessed for your home.

FIESTA DE LA PRESENTACIÓN DEL SEÑOR

JUEVES, 2 DE FEBRERO DE 2023 | MISA A LAS 7PM (BILINGÜE)

El Evangelio de Lucas es el único que menciona la Presentación del Señor en el Templo. El 2 de febrero es exactamente cuarenta días después del 25 de diciembre, la natividad de Jesús. La ley judía (Ex 13:2, 12) dictaba que Jesús, como primogénito, fuera consagrado a Dios. Esto lo hicieron los padres al presentar a su Hijo en el Templo.

La ley judía especificaba además (Lv 12:2-8) que una madre era ritualmente impura después de dar a luz y que tenía que esperar un periodo de tiempo determinado (cuarenta días para un varón) antes de ofrecer un sacrificio al Señor para la purificación.

La convergencia de estas dos normas judías da lugar al relato de Lucas tanto de la Presentación del Señor como de la Purificación de María. En estos días el énfasis litúrgico está más en la Presentación de Jesús. Lucas destaca el papel de Simeón y Ana, dos judíos justos que reconocieron a Jesús como el Mesías largamente esperado y alabaron a Dios por haber podido ver y experimentar tal maravilla en sus vidas.

La oración de Simeón sobre el papel especial de Jesús afirma que Jesús es "una luz para revelación a los gentiles". Esta frase finalmente originó la costumbre de bendecir velas en este día que debían usarse en las ceremonias, rituales y procesiones durante todo el año eclesialístico. Por lo tanto, el 2 de febrero también se conoce como el Día de la Candelaria. Este día es en verdad una rica fiesta para ser saboreada.

Todos son bienvenidos a traer velas para ser bendecidas para su hogar.

COMMUNITY INPUT REQUESTED 2022-23 COLLIER COMMUNITY ASSESSMENT

In 2018, a Collier County Community Assessment provided information about the strengths of our community, and identified areas of greatest need, leading to many initiatives that would not have happened without the input of our community, such as:

- Greater emphasis on and increased funding in early learning
- The launch of the private/public housing initiative to increase attainable housing for essential workers
- Increased awareness of and funding for both mental health, and career and technical education



After five years, it is time to take a new snapshot of Collier County—of gains that have been made and remaining gaps.

The assessment process will use the same components: research and data, focus groups and surveys. Community member feedback is very important so that the needs of the Golden Gate area are well represented! The survey is open through March 2023. In order to provide that broad perspective, Collier County residents 18+ years are encouraged to complete it, whether they are full time or seasonal.
