The Debt We Owe

Mercy and forgiveness should be at the heart of the Christian life. Yet, as today's First Reading wisely reminds us, often we cherish our wrath, nourish our anger, and refuse mercy to those who have done us wrong. Jesus, too, strikes close to home in today's Gospel with His realistic portrayal of the wicked servant who won't forgive a fellow servant's debt, even though his own slate has just been wiped clean by their master.



It can't be this way in the kingdom, the Church. In the Old Testament, seven is frequently a number associated with mercy and the forgiveness of sins. The just man sins seven times daily; there is a sevenfold sprinkling of blood for atonement of sins (see Proverbs 24:6; Leviticus 16). But Jesus tells Peter today that we must forgive not seven times, but seventy times seven times. That means: every time. We are to be merciful as our Father in heaven is merciful (see Luke 6:36; Matthew 5:48). But why? Why does Jesus repeatedly warn that we can't expect forgiveness for our trespasses unless we're willing to forgive others their trespasses against us? Because, as Paul reminds us in today's Epistle, we are the Lord's. Each of us has been purchased by the blood of Christ shed for us on the Cross (see Revelation 5:9). As we sing in today's Psalm, though we deserved to die for our sins, He doesn't deal with us according to our crimes. The mercy and forgiveness we show to others should be the heartfelt expression of our gratitude for the

mercy and forgiveness shown to us. This is why we should remember our last days, set our enmities aside, and stop judging others. We know that one day we will stand before the judgment seat and give account for what we've done with the new life given to us by Christ (see Romans 14:10, 12). So we forgive each other from the heart, overlook each other's faults, and await the crown of His kindness and compassion.

MILAGROS

Los milagros son signos de oraciones ofrecidas a Dios en el Nombre de Jesús. Su propósito es ayudarte a orar. "Milagro" significa literalmente "milagro" o "sorpresa". Un medallón votivo Milagro es una costumbre española que se remonta a los primeros siglos del cristianismo en la Península Ibérica y es popular en España y América Latina. Milagros se puede ofrecer como recordatorio de la necesidad particular de una persona, o en agradecimiento por una oración respondida o como devoción a un santo en particular.



La belleza de las medallas Milagros es que realmente pueden simbolizar lo que quieras. ¡El único límite para el vínculo entre el Milagro y tu oración es la imaginación! Aquí hay unos ejemplos:

- Brazo: trabajo, fuerza, tacto, abrazo.
- Pájaro: un mensaje o mensajero, libertad, viaje espiritual, paz.
- Perro: el perro de uno, protección, lealtad
- Oído: disposición a escuchar, estar abierto.
- Clave: sentido de la vida o el viaje a través del cambio, sabiduría
- Mula: trabajo, viaje, terquedad.
- Cerdo: abundancia, alimentación, trabajadores agrícolas.
- Rosa: Respeto a la vida, el amor, una relación, Santa Teresa de Lisieux
- Estrella: guía, sabiduría, María, esperanza, viaje por mar

Instrucciones:

1. Compre un Milagros en el mostrador de bienvenida en el Nártex o en la oficina parroquial, tres por \$5.
2. Visita la estatua del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús en la iglesia para rezar.
3. Deja a tus Milagros en la caja de madera.

Una vez a la semana, un miembro del personal cuelga a todas las Milagros detrás de la estatua.

MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICO - ALENTAR ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

17 DE SEPTIEMBRE DE 2023 - 24º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Perdonemos a los demás como Dios nos perdona. Son palabras muy fáciles pero muy profundas para llevar a cabo. El Evangelio nos habla de la necesidad del perdón. Pedro va al grano y pregunta a Jesús por una solución rápida y hasta es matemático, habla de números. ¿Cómo dar solución a los celos, envidia, infidelidad, y tensiones por mencionar algo? ¿En síntesis, cuántas veces debo perdonar al que me ofende? La respuesta de Jesús a Pedro y a nosotros ahora es la misma: "No te digo siete, sino setenta veces siete" (Mateo 18:22). Perdonar siempre. La Oración Colecta ayuda a que reflexionemos en la misericordia de Dios y nos ayude a perdonar: "Señor Dios, creador soberano de todas las cosas, vuelve a nosotros tus ojos y concede que te sirvamos de todo corazón, para que experimentemos los efectos de tu misericordia".



¿No debías tú también tener compasión como yo tuve de ti? Compasión y misericordia son las palabras claves del mensaje de Jesús. No tiene sentido llevar cuentas del perdón, tiene más sentido ver la bondad de Dios hacia nosotros y que siempre nos perdona. "Perdono, pero no olvido". Demuestra que no se es capaz de perdonar desde el fondo del corazón. ¿Has experimentado el perdón de Dios? ¿Cómo ves a la familia, comunidad y sociedad en general en cuestión de perdonar? ¿Puedes ser tú instrumento de Dios para llevar el perdón donde se necesite? No olvides que: "El Señor es compasivo y misericordioso" (Salmo 102).

MILAGROS

They are signs of prayers offered to God in the Name of Jesus. Their purpose is to help you pray. "Milagro" literally means "miracle" or "surprise". A votive Milagro medallion is a Spanish custom dating back to the earliest centuries of Christianity on the Iberian Peninsula and are popular in Spain and Latin America. Milagros can be offered as a reminder of a petitioner's particular need, or in gratitude for a prayer answered.

The beauty of Milagros medals is they can really symbolize whatever you like. The only

limit to the tie between the Milagro and your prayer is imagination! Here are some examples:

- Arm: work, strength, touch, embrace
- Bird: a message or messenger, freedom, spiritual journey, peace
- Dog: one's dog, protection, loyalty
- Ear: willingness to listen, being open
- Key: meaning of life or the journey through change, wisdom
- Mule: work, travel, stubbornness
- Pig: abundance, eating, farm workers
- Rose: Respect Life, love, a relationship, St. Thérèse of Lisieux
- Star: guidance, wisdom, Mary, hope, travel by sea

Directions:

1. Purchase a Milagros at the Welcome Desk in the Narthex or at the Parish Office.
2. Visit the Sacred Heart of Jesus statue in the church to pray.
3. Leave your Milagros in the wooden box.

Once a week all Milagros are hung behind the statue by a staff member.
