## MILAGROS

The beauty of Milagros medals is they can really symbolize whatever you like. They are signs of prayers offered to God in the Name of Jesus. Their purpose is to help you pray.

1. Purchase a Milagros at the Welcome Desk in the Narthex or at the Parish Office (3 for \$5)
2. Visit the Sacred Heart of Jesus statue in the church and pray.
3. Leave your Milagros in the wooden box.

Once a week all Milagros are hung behind the statue by a staff member.



# Members of the Wedding

**A**ccording to marriage customs of Jesus' day, a bride was first "betrothed" to her husband but continued for a time to live with her family. Then, at the appointed hour some months later, the groom would come to claim her, leading her family and bridal party to the wedding feast that would celebrate and inaugurate their new life together. This is the background to the parable of the last judgment we hear in today's Gospel.



In the parable's symbolism, Jesus is the Bridegroom (see Mark 2:19). In this, He fulfills God's ancient promise to join Himself forever to His chosen people as a husband cleaves to his bride (see Hosea 2:16–20). The virgins of the bridal party represent us, the members of the Church. We were "betrothed" to Jesus in Baptism (see 2 Corinthians 11:2; Ephesians 5:25–27) and are called to lives of holiness and devotion until He comes again to lead us to the heavenly wedding feast at the end of time (see Revelation 19:7–9; 21:1–4). As St. Paul warns in today's Epistle, Jesus is coming again, though we know not the day nor the hour.

We need to keep vigil throughout the dark night of this time in which our Bridegroom seems long delayed. We need to keep our souls' lamps filled with the oil of perseverance and desire for God—virtues that are extolled in today's First Reading and Psalm. We are to seek Him in love, meditating upon His kindness, calling upon His name, striving to be ever more worthy of Him, to be found without

spot or blemish when He comes.

If we do this, we will be counted as wise and the oil for our lamps will not run dry (see 1 Kings 17:16). We will perceive the Bridegroom, the Wisdom of God (see Proverbs 8:12–21, 35; 9:1–6), hastening toward us, beckoning us to the table He has prepared, the rich banquet which will satisfy our souls.

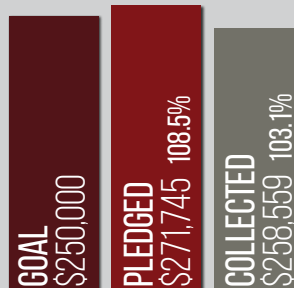

## PLANNING AHEAD? CHRISTMAS

Christmas is on a Monday this year which means Christmas Eve Vigil Masses are on Sunday evening. Sunday, December 24 is also the 4th Sunday of Advent. So, the Sunday morning Masses (7:30am, 9am and 11am) count for the Sunday Obligation and the Sunday evening Masses (5pm, 7pm and Midnight) count for the Christmas obligation. Both Sunday, Dec. 24 (and all Sundays) and Christmas are Holy Days of Obligation.

## SAVE ON TAXES & MAKE A GREATER IMPACT!

If you have reached the age that you have to take a required minimum distribution (RMD) from your IRA, did you know that you can transfer up to \$100,000 each year from your IRA directly to your favorite Catholic charity, like St Elizabeth Seton Parish? By rolling over your IRA distribution directly to a charity, it qualifies as your RMD and you avoid having to include the distribution as taxable income. Beginning in 2023, the age at which RMDs must start is 73, however, individuals can begin making Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) from their IRAs as early as age 70½.

- Distribute up to \$100,000 in a calendar year from your IRA (regardless of the size of your RMD) directly to the charity, tax free
- If your spouse has a separate IRA, he or she can also make a qualified charitable distribution up to \$100,000
- Transfer your full RMD or only a portion of it
- Decide each year if and/or how much of your RMD to use
- Support multiple charities

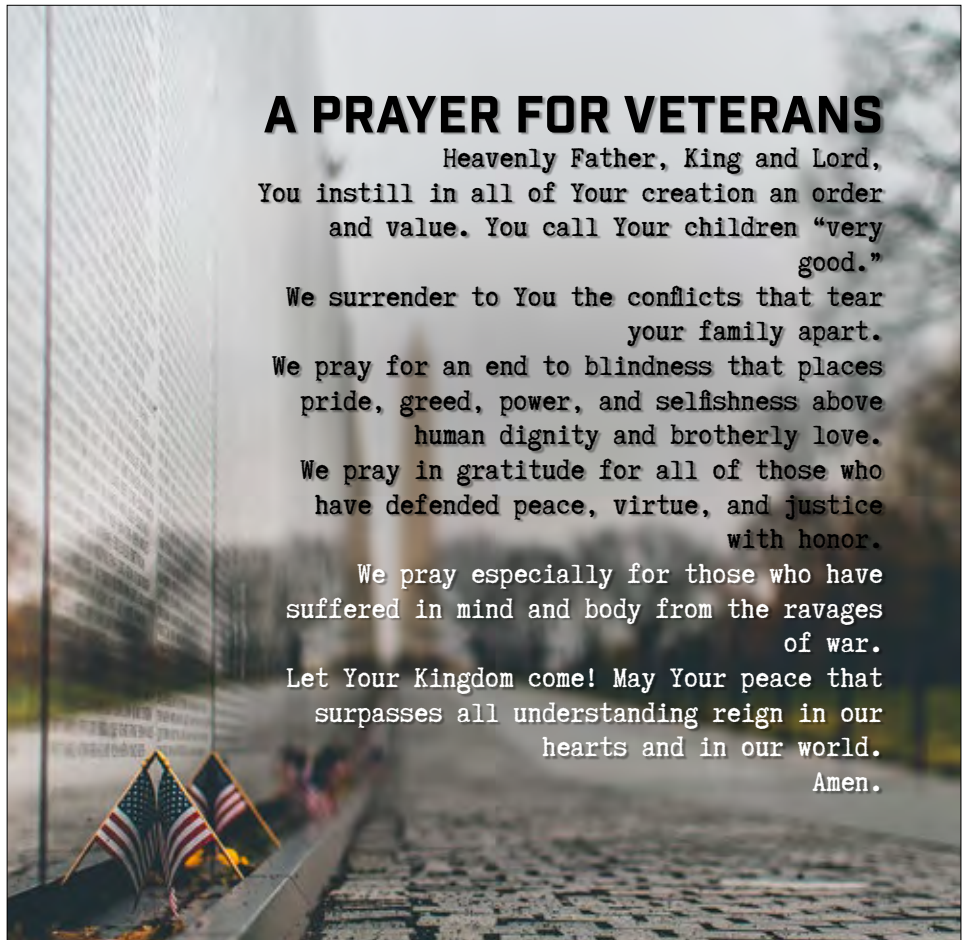
